Your child will be allocated a “Key Person”. This person’s role is to ensure your child’s individual care and learning needs are met. They will ensure that your child’s learning is tailored specifically to them to enable them to develop to their full potential during their time in Little EIFA.

Your child’s key person will give you verbal feedback at the end of each day and will also provide weekly updates on your child’s learning. At the end of each school term you will receive a written summary report for your child and twice a year will be invited to have a parent-teacher meeting with your child’s key person.

Details of your child’s key person will be sent to you individually on Thursday 26th August.

Drop off time: Between 8am - 9am

- Please enter via Cavendish Mews if you are bringing a pushchair/scooter
- Please enter via 36 Portland Place if you have no pushchair

Collection time: Dependent on individual booking session

- Morning session – 12pm
- School day session – 3.30pm
- Full day – 6pm

For the start of nursery please ensure you bring the following:

- Spare clothes (top, trousers/skirt, underwear, socks/tights)
- Welly boots
- Reusable water bottle
- A blanket and comforter if they have an afternoon nap

Each child has a coat hook, a small box for clothing and space for boots so you do not have to bring things daily.

Please ensure all items of clothing and belongings are clearly named to avoid any mix-ups or things going missing. We kindly ask that your child does not bring toys to school, as they can easily get lost within the classroom.
